Terms and Conditions

You and your dogs

Please ensure that your dogs are adequately vaccinated to use a public place. If your dog is showing any signs of illness do not use the field and be respectful of other pets and their owners.

At your own risk - uneven ground, long grass

You agree that your use of the field is at your own risk, and agree not to hold 'FURRY FRIENDS FREEDOM FIELD' and its owners or staff responsible for any injury to you, your family/friends or your dogs arising from your use of the field. The field is a large outdoor space, and contains areas of uneven ground which could be concealed under long grass. It has overhanging branches from trees around the edges which may fall or have fallen and could contain other hazards consistent with the countryside.

You agree not to let anyone else onto the field other than any friends or family members you have brought with you to enjoy walking your dogs in your pre booked one hour slot.

By bringing friends or family, or sending somebody in place of you, you agree that you take full responsibility for their safety and for ensuring that they abide by these terms and conditions at all times whilst using the field.

Children

You are welcome to bring your children to the field, but they must be supervised at all times, and you are responsible for making sure that they do not injure themselves or break any of these terms and conditions. Please be aware that the field has not been made child safe, and that certain elements may pose an additional hazard to children (non-child proof dog poo bins for example). Please ensure no children use our agility green equipment as a playground and abide by the NO CLIMBING signs.

Buildings and specific obstacles

You agree not to enter any buildings or force entry on any lockups. Abide by the no climbing signs.

The fence

Although we will be inspecting and maintaining the fence regularly, holes or other damage to the fence may occur from time to time due to a number of reasons including digging by dogs or other animals, falling trees or branches, and general wear and tear. If you become aware of any issue with the state of the fence, please let us know **immediately** so that we can make other users aware and so that we can fix it as soon as possible. We cannot however, take any responsibility for any dog escaping the field whether or not this is through a defect in the fence, and regardless of whether we have notified you in advance or not. We advise on your first visit to walk the perimeter with your dog on the lead so they can get used to the surroundings before letting them off.

Using the field

Please wait outside on the road to allow the field user before you to leave. Once you enter the field ensure you close and padlock the main gates they are to be kept shut and locked at all times.

Please ensure that you do not arrive early for your booking and vacate the field leaving it secure at the end of your booking MAKING SURE THE PADLOCK IS SECURING THE GATES.

Please only park on the hardstanding (i.e. the area marked parking bay) please reverse park into the parking bay this allows you to leave swiftly and enables you to have more than one car per booking. If you have multiple cars for one booking you can park in front of the large wooden gates then reverse into the parking bay once that car in the parking bay has left first.

You must keep your dog on the lead until you have entered the field and closed the gate behind you before letting your dog(s) off the lead. This is to ensure the safety of the dog(s), nearby road users and members of the public.

It is your responsibly to pick up all of your dog's waste and dispose of it in the Poo bin provided.

PLEASE DO NOT REVERSE DOWN OUR TRACK OR DRIVE ONTO THE GRASS! This spoils the look of our field and takes a lot of maintenance to restore the grass.

Noise

You are reminded that although the field may feel remote, is situated close to neighbouring property. Please do your best to keep noise (such as continuous barking, or loud children) to a minimum, so as not to disturb any neighbours.

Bookings

Bookings that are cancelled within 24 hours of our slot are still chargable. But you can reschedule and your payment will be carried over. We try and run a rather relaxed procedure here at Furry Friends.

All bookings must be paid for at the time of booking.

Updates

We may need to vary these terms and conditions from time to time. When we do this we will let you know via text/email.
